



6. The method of attachment between the façade and the tent framing must be secure and able to withstand wind loads and horizontal forces in excess of 35 miles per hour. Unacceptable means of attachment include tape, wire and cable ties.

7. Facades must accommodate the anchoring system of the underlying tent structure. Each outside corner of the tent is typically attached to a stake or water barrel at a 30 – 45 degree angle with a rope or ratchet strap.

8. Facades that extend above the horizontal cross framing of the tent must include space to affix a standard 20" x 120" menu board supported by the plywood framing of the structure.

9. Plywood facades must be painted on all sides.

10. Non-compliant or unapproved facades will be subject for removal.
